- 3) No Objection Certificate of respective Port Trust/Organization.
- 4) An Undertaking of the applicant not to withdraw, if selected.
- Vigilance/Administrative clearance of the concerned Port in the prescribed proforma as per Ministry's letter No.A12022/10/205-PE-I, dt.27.08.2010 and also revised instructions issued thereon.

If any major or minor penalty is imposed on the applicant during the last 10 years, the details of the disciplinary case leading to such penalty along with necessary documents may be sent for forwarding to Government along with application.

It is also requested to ensure about the veracity of the University certificates and recognition of the Degree obtained by the applicants and certificate to that effect may be given by the Head of office. The applications received through proper channel will only be entertained. The applications received after the last date or without ACRs or otherwise incomplete will not be considered.
