

Launch of Harit Sagar – Green Port guidelines and Sagar Shrestha Sammaan Awards

The guidelines aimed at the vision of achieving Zero Carbon Emission Goal. Harit Sagar Guidelines – 2023 envisages ecosystem dynamics in port development, operation, and maintenance while aligning with the 'Working with Nature' concept. It lays emphasis on use of clean or green energy in the Port operation, developing Port capabilities for storage, handling, and bunkering greener fuels like Green Hydrogen, Green Ammonia, and Green Methanol or Ethanol.

This is in tune with "Panchamrit" commitments announced by Prime Minister Narendra Modi for achieving quantifiable reductions in carbon emissions over a period.
