2. E.M.D. Rs.2,460/- to be paid in the form of crossed Demand Draft drawn in favour of FA&CAO/VPT, VSP.(refundable) with a validity of 03 months from the date of opening of the tender.
3. Earnest Money of Rs.2,460/- shall be paid to the Financial Adviser & Chief Accounts Officer/VPT in cash or Bank Draft issued by any nationalized Banks/ Scheduled Banks and No Cheques will be entertained under any circumstances. The E.M.D. paid will not carry any interest. The Earnest Money of unsuccessful Tenderers will be refunded. Bids received without EMD will be summarily rejected.
4. All the eligible Bidders, who are registered with NSIC/Ministry of MSME are exempted from payment of EMD amount and Tender Document Cost subject to submission of valid NSIC/MSME. Certificate and request letter for exemption Tender and EMD cost.
5. Validity of offer should **3 months** from the date of receipt of the quotationThe firm shall submit copies of executed work orders in Govt. / Private Firms to prove their experience in executing similar works in the last seven years. Similar works shall mean experience in “Fabrication and Installation of structural steel/pipeline.“

10. The quotations received without complying with any of the above points is liable for rejection without assigning any reason.
11. The offer of the firm is liable for rejection in case of past poor performance record with VPT i.e. Quality, Delivery etc.,
12. The workmanship and materials used in this work shall be guaranteed for a period of **12 months** from the date of completion of the work.
13. Tender is to be submitted in a sealed cover duly super scribing the name of work and addressed to the AXE(M), Visakhapatnam Port Trust, Visakhapatnam.
14. Work completion period should be 30 days from the date of Site clearance.
15. The replaced components spares if any shall be returned to VPT stores after completion of work.
16. In case work is delayed beyond reasonable time, VPT at its discretion will confiscate and the work will be executed at the cost, risks & responsibility of the contractor apart from initiating legal action as per the extent rules
17. SAFETY MEASURES: The contractor is responsible for taking precautionary measures for the safety of lives of men working under him and the responsibility arising due to any mishap during the execution of work, the payment of any compensation etc., lies entirely on the part of the contractor
18. Firm/Contractor has to comply with QMS, EMS, OHSAS and ISPS norms of VPT.

19. Forfeiting of EMD: If the successful bidder failed to furnish security or refuse to execute the work in accordance with his accepted tender, EMD will be forfeited and Board may thereon award the contract to another bidder.
20. Firm quoted rate shall be exclusive of all taxes and duties taxes will be reimbursed on submission of documentary proofs.
21. The required Tools and trackels, Materials (viz. Ropes, Pulleys, Seaffolding Shovels, Buckets ect. Which are necessary) welding machine fasteners and consumables and crane if required are in the scope of the contractor.
22. The contractor shall comply the requirements of all the ISO systems i.e. QMS, EMS and OSHAS.
