NOTIFICATION

G.S.R. 396(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-section (1) of Section 124, read with Sub-section (1) of Section 132 of the Major Port Trusts Act, 1963 (38 of 1963), the Central Government hereby approves the Visakhapatnam Port Trust Employees (Recruitment, Seniority and Promotion) Amendment Regulations, 2013 made by the Board of Trustees of Visakhapatnam Port Trust and set out in the Schedule annexed to this Notification.

The said Regulations shall come into force from the date of publication of this Notification in the Official Gazette.

SCHEDULE

VISAKHAPATNAM PORT TRUST

Visakhapatnam Port Trust Employees (Recruitment, Seniority and Promotion) Amendment Regulations, 2013

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 28 of the Major Port Trusts Act, 1963 (38 of 1963), the Board of Trustees of the Visakhapatnam Port Trust hereby makes the following regulations to further amend the Visakhapatnam Port Trust Employees (Recruitment, Seniority and Promotion) Regulations, 2009 as amended from time to time.

1. Short Title and Commencement:—

(i) These Regulations may be called as Visakhapatnam Port Trust Employees (Recruitment, Seniority and Promotion) Amendment Regulations, 2013.

(ii) They shall come into force from the date of publication of the approval of the Central Government as required under the provisions of Sections 124 and 132 of the Major Port Trusts Act, 1963 in the Gazette of India.

2. In the Schedule annexed to the Visakhapatnam Port Employees (Recruitment, Seniority and Promotion) Regulations, 2009, in the Recruitment Rules for Class-I posts in Medical Department:—

(i) For the post of Sr. Dy Chief Medical Officer at S1. No. 2.—

(a) the provisions under Column 9 shall be substituted as under:—

“(i) MBBS degree from a recognized University.

A post graduate (PG) medical degree/diploma in the specified specialty from a recognized university and post qualification experience of 10 years in case of PG degree holders and 12 years experience in case of PG diploma holders in a reputed hospital in the relevant field of specialization.”

(b) under column 10 (c), the words “No”, shall be substituted by the words “Yes”

(ii) For the post of Dy Chief Medical Officer (Specialist) at S1. No. 3(a).—

(a) the provisions under Column 9 shall be substituted as under:—

“(i) MBBS degree from a recognized University.

- (ii) A post graduate (PG) medical degree/diploma in the specified specialty from a recognized university and post qualification experience of 7 years in case of PG degree holders and 9 years experience in case of PG diploma holders in a reputed hospital in the relevant field of specialization.”
- (b) under column 10 (c), the words “No”, shall be substituted by the words “Yes”
- (iii) For the post of Sr. Medical Officer (Specialist) at S1. No. 4(a), the provisions under Column 9 shall be substituted as under :—
- “(i) MBBS degree from a recognized university, or for Sr. Medical Officer (Dental); BDS degree of a recognized university.
- (ii) A post graduate (PG) medical degree/diploma in the specified specialty from a recognized university and post qualification experience of 3 years in case of PG degree holders and 5 years experience in case of PG diploma holders in a reputed hospital in the relevant field of specialization.”
