The undersigned being an Appellate Authority under provisions of Right to Information ACT, 2005, has carefully gone through your appeal, vide, reference 2rd cited and the relevant records connected to the said appeal.

On such carefully examination of the appeal and relevant records, it is to inform that the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Hyderabad has passed orders dt.20.12.2018 for medical reimbursement for the treatment done at KIMS in the year 2013 only. The same has already been reimbursed to the pensioner in his monthly pension for the month of September, 2019.

Regarding Ministry letter dt.08.11.2019, you have made representation to Ministry vide letter dt.25.09.2019 that you have claimed Rs.7, 61,665/- and VPT reimbursed only Rs.2, 27,749.69ps. It is to inform that, though he has not reported to CMO within the stipulated time for treatment taken at private un-recognised hospital the expenditure incurred by him was restricted as per CGHS tariff in terms of Hon'ble Court orders dt.20.12.2018 and Rs.2, 27,749.69 was paid to him in the month of September, 2019 pension with the approval of the then Chairman.

Regarding the representation dt.20.11.2019, it is to inform that a detailed reply was already given to you vide this office letters dt.29.11.2019 & dt.29.01.2020 that reimbursement of medical expenses towards the treatment taken at Tarakarama Cancer Hospital, Hyderabad claimed vide your letter dt.20.11.2019 cannot be considered in terms of the letter dt.17.05.2019 addressed by CMO to you.

Regarding you representation dt.11.06.2020 for reimbursement of Rs.1,10,815/- for undergoing operation at KIMS hospital, it is to inform that it was clearly informed in the Court order dt.20.12.2018 that medical reimbursement for treatment took in KIMS intimated vide your representation dt.23.08.2013 only is to be reimbursed. It has not passed orders to pay all the bills submitted by Sri J.Hari Kumar whenever he undergoes treatment. CMO vide letter dt.17.09.2019 has stated, that the pensioner cannot avail treatment as he wish at the un-recognized hospital without any intimation to the Medical department.
